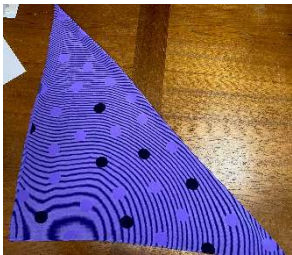
Assembling the pattern piece.

It is important that you set your printer options to “no scaling”. Measure the 1-inch square to be sure the pattern printed correctly. Cut out your pattern and then tape the bottom of both pieces together.

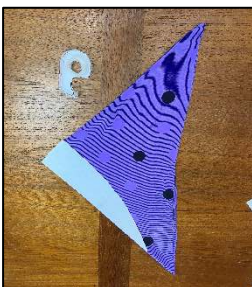
Cut one piece of fabric that measures 24 inches by 24 inches square.

Fold in half diagonally so that two of the corners are touching. This will create a triangle.

Fold this triangle in half one more time - taking the left point and folding it to the right point. Your fabric should look like the image below.



Place your pattern template along the bottom edge of the fabric (along the fold) as shown.



Trace the template and cut.

Cut 1.5 inches off the right corner.

Open the fabric back up and turn the fabric right sides together. Pin in place.

Sew the two pieces together using a $\frac{1}{4}$ seam allowance. Leave an opening of about 3-4 inches on one of the straight edges.

Turn the bandana right sides out and press. Make sure to fold in your seam allowance at the opening. Pin the opening closed.

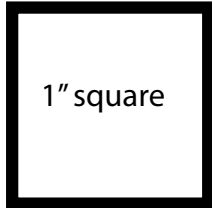
Finish your bandana by topstitching a scant $\frac{1}{8}$ all the way around. This will securely close the opened section.
