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Easy / Facile / Fácil

**Notes:** This bandana can be worn many ways, a kerchief; bandana or headwrap. All rows have a standard return pass unless otherwise noted. The pattern is written to fit a standard head size of 18-21 in. after blocking. To adjust size, repeat rows 4 and 5 to desired length. Keep in mind yardage when adjusting.

**Gauge:** 18 tss x 16 rows = 4 in. Blocked.

## Materials

Tunisian Crochet hook J (6.0 mm) or hook to obtain gauge, with 12 in. cord

Yarn needle

Tape measure

Sample: Queenie's Crochet DK in Aubergine 218 yards/ 200 meters/ 100 grams

Yarn: Any purple DK weight

Yardage: 109 yards/ 99.66 meters/50 grams

## Abbreviations

Ch= chain(s)

M1= make one increase

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep= Repeat

RetP = Return pass

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tss= Tunisian simple stitch

**Special Stitches:** Make one increase (M1)- Increase one stitch by inserting your hook in the back bump of the previous return ch, pull up a loop. (see photo on last page)

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## Instructions

**Row 1:** Ch 6. Pull up a loop in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch and in each rem ch.

**Row 2-3:** Tss all sts.

**Row 4:** [Tss1, M1] 2 times, Tss rem sts.

**Row 5:** Tss all sts.

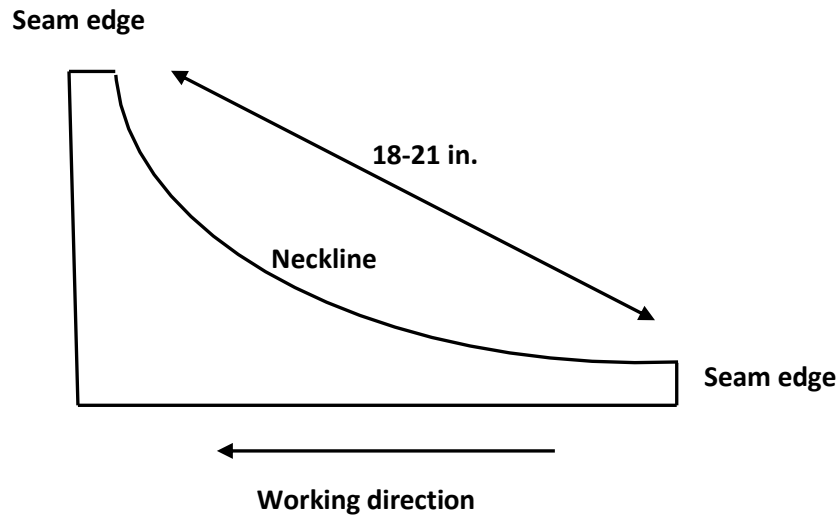
Rep rows 4 and 5 until piece reaches 17 in. along the diagonal edge. Repeat row 5 three more times.

Bind off all sts. Cut the yarn. Leave a long enough tail to seam.

## Finishing

Wet block to measurement before seaming.

Using the mattress stitch, seam at edges indicated by diagram. Cut the yarn. Weave in ends.



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M1 increase- Increase one stitch by inserting your hook in the back bump of the previous return ch, pull up a loop.

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
